## Annual Report

As we enter the third year of the pandemic, it can feel like little has changed since everything started, or maybe even like there's little to celebrate. We're here to tell you, however, that a virus is no match for our God, and that even when we are tired, He never stops working!

Thanks to your time, energy, prayers, and financial support, a lot happened here at YANA this past year. Here's an overview of the highlights:

Now in its eighth year(2022), YSAP has brought over a total of eight Korean students (ranging in grades from middle school to college) to study in the U.S. since its inception. In June, we celebrated our first college graduation with the very first student to join our program (congrats, Eunji!), and our most recent student graduated high school and began attending college. ## YANA 119



In Korea, the number to dial for emergencies is “119,” and we certainly felt the urgency this year. While we’ve always known of the many ways young adults struggle after aging out of group homes, we were contacted in March by Kyeongmin Kim, a 25-year-old who was diagnosed with osteosarcoma (bone) cancer, but could not afford treatment. Moved by his story, we created YANA 119 to help abandoned young adults seek the medical care they critically need, but could not previously afford. Since March, we’ve partnered with 45 clinics and doctors, and disbursed \$15,000 to 12 young adults.

## YNOT Conference

In June, we gathered 31 organizations across Korea, Canada, and the U.S. to hold our first annual YNOT Conference. With services supporting single mothers, adoptees, children in group homes, and young adults who have aged out of the system, these organizations work across the full spectrum of orphan care in Korea. We were joined by actress Aera Shin and Starbucks Korea CEO David Song, who gave keynote speeches that rallied and encouraged us all. A leadership group was established in September, and planning is already underway for the 2022 conference. We look forward to the new environment of collaboration and support that can grow out of this group as we continue improving the ways we serve our youth together.



## Project JOY

After an incredibly long wait, Seungho Jo was finally granted his H-1 visa this past September and has returned to the U.S.! Seungho is a young adult who first interned at Joy Systems—a computer refurbishing company—in 2019. At the end of his internship, he knew that he wanted to return and applied to be sponsored for an H-1 work visa, but COVID-19 and fluctuating immigration policies delayed the process extensively. Although the wait was years-long (and at one point, we had all but given up hope), we’re so thankful that God has allowed this to finally happen. Seungho is now working at Joy Systems as a computer repair specialist.

Partnerships with Social Enterprise



YANA wants to be a presence that reassures not only abandoned youth and young adults, but also those who look to serve and love on them that “you are not alone.” This past year, we partnered with a social enterprise\* in Korea called Brother’s Keeper, a company that manages office plant environments for clients. With a slogan that roughly translates to “Caring for people, caring for nature,” Brother’s Keeper focuses on primarily hiring young adults who have aged out of the system, with programs designed to help foster career growth, emotional independence, and better self-reliance. In 2021, we were able to help provide one year’s salary for one of their employees.

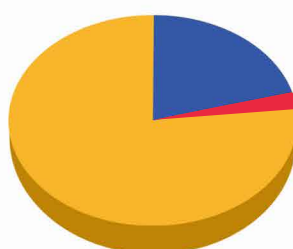

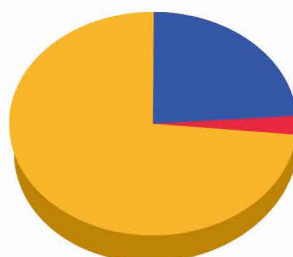
